You Are Invited to Join the Honduras Mission Trip 2023!

The sponsoring churches (Ballardsville BC, DeHaven BC, Westport BC, and Corn Creek BC) for a Honduras mission trip slated for March 4-19, 2023 welcome others from our Network churches to join us on this important Gospel mission enterprise. Bro. Rick Lucas is serving as the coordinator for this trip.

The trip consists of work in two very different regions - La Campa, in the remote western mountains, and Tela, a town on the Caribbean coast. Volunteers can opt for the trip to La Campa (March 4-12) or to Tela (March 12 -19) or the entire trip.

In La Campa, the team will be working with missionaries Greg and Jean Hines to do construction work, conduct a medical clinic, minister to school children, and share the Gospel in the surrounding communities. In Tela, the team will be working with Pastor Franklin Requeno to do construction work, hold a medical clinic, work with school children, and share the Gospel in the community.




