Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer. (Romans 12:12)

I love that Paul's reminder to "be constant in prayer" is bracketed by two opposite ends of the human experience. There is hope and rejoicing on one end, and tribulation and patient endurance on the other. Prayer, however, is the proper and needful response in all situations. When times are difficult, turning to the Lord in prayer will help us find the patience and strength that we need to endure the trials and experience the hope that comes from our Savior. When times are good and hope is fulfilled, turning to the Lord in prayer is one of the ways we rejoice and give glory to Him as the One who provides, saves, and sustains us through every season of life. So, with this verse and thought on my mind, I want to ask our Network churches to pray about a few things.

First, I want to share with you that Rev. Phillip Bruce, pastor at Union Grove BC in Trimble Co., went home to be with the Lord on Monday, May 22. Bro. Phillip had faithfully served Union Grove as pastor since 2008. He was a kind and gracious man whose faith in the Lord was always front and center, even as he faced the difficulties of cancer over the past several months. Please pray that God would bless his wife, Marie, and their family with comfort and peace as they walk the difficult path of grief. Pray also for Union Grove BC as they mourn the loss of their pastor and seek the Lord's guidance for the road ahead.

Second, I want to welcome Rev. Shawn Golden, the new pastor at Cropper BC. Bro. Shawn began his service as pastor at Cropper on Sunday, May 7. This is a time of joy and hope as Bro. Shawn and the church set forth on the journey of serving the Lord together. Please pray for God to bless them with wisdom, guidance, and strength through the presence of His Spirit as the share the love and grace of Jesus Christ in their community.

Finally, the KBC will soon be releasing the 2020 Lostness Indicators for Kentucky. An early glimpse at the numbers reveals a continued decline in church attendance across our Network area. When the study was first done in 2010, only 9.9% of the population in Henry, Oldham, Shelby, Spencer, and Trimble Counties attended church (any denomination) on any given Sunday. As of 2020, that number has decreased to 8.46%. That's less than 1 out of 10 people attending church on any given Sunday in our 5-county area.

Friends, these numbers are a sober call for us to prayer. We need to pray for the lost, the unchurched, and the de-churched. We need to pray for pastors, churches, fellow believers, and ourselves. We need to pray for revival in our hearts and in our congregations. We need to pray for the Holy Spirit to move in great and mighty ways through our churches, homes, and communities. We need to fall on our faces in repentance before God and ask Him to push back the darkness through the power of His light, love, and grace. My friends, we need to be constant in prayer!
