Summer is just around the corner! That can mean many things to many different people. Gardening, grass mowing, cookouts, picnics, road trips, and vacations are all things that people do in the warmer weather.

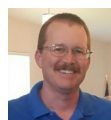
Summer is also time when churches tend to be more active in reaching out with the Good News through ministry and missions. Vacation Bible School is a proven way for churches to connect with families in their communities. VBS also provides great opportunities for sharing the Gospel. This happens most obviously throughout the week as VBS workers teach the truths of the Bible to the children. Gospel sharing can also happen if the church holds a family event to celebrate the week of VBS. Additionally, if churches do intentional follow-up with their VBS guests/families, they will find opportunities for Gospel-centered conversations.

Mission trips and projects frequently happen in the summer as well. These mission endeavors can take on many different forms. One church might minister to a local neighbor by doing yard work or helping with home repairs. Another church might partner with a local ministry to serve their neighbors and share about Jesus. Reaching further abroad, some churches send their students and adult volunteers to coordinated mission projects like KY Changers. Other congregations send teams to work with IMB and NAMB supported missionaries around our nation and world. Participating in these types of efforts provides a way for churches to fulfill the Great Commission by making disciples to the ends of the earth. It also helps churches disciple their own members as they learn and grow in their faith through real-life practical experiences.

All of this brings me to the two requests I would like to make through this article. First, please pray for all these summer mission and ministry activities in your church and among our Network churches. In Luke, Jesus notes the plentiful harvest that needs to be brought in. He also shares that the laborers are few. These two realities have not changed and Jesus' call to pray for workers is just as urgent today as it was in His day. Pray that God will call out His people to go forth and serve Him through VBS, block parties, follow-up visits, outreach ministries, mission projects, and mission trips both near and far.

On page 7 in this newsletter, there is a list that includes the Vacation Bible Schools happening around our Network. Please use this list as you pray. There are also a few mission trips or opportunities listed. Pray for them as well. We know there are more going on than what is listed. Please send Amanda (info@ncbnetwork.org) the information about your church's VBS and other summer mission efforts and we will include it in our June newsletter. Additionally, if your church is sending a team on a mission trip, and that trip is open to participants from other churches, please let us know so we can share that as well. We want to see all of these endeavors supported by prayer across our Network.

What a beautiful and powerful witness it would be to have our Network churches praying for one another and working together to carry the good news of Jesus Christ to the lost in our local communities, state, nation, and world!

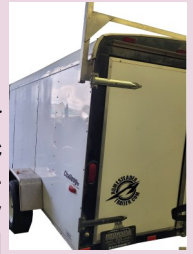
OUTREACH Trailer

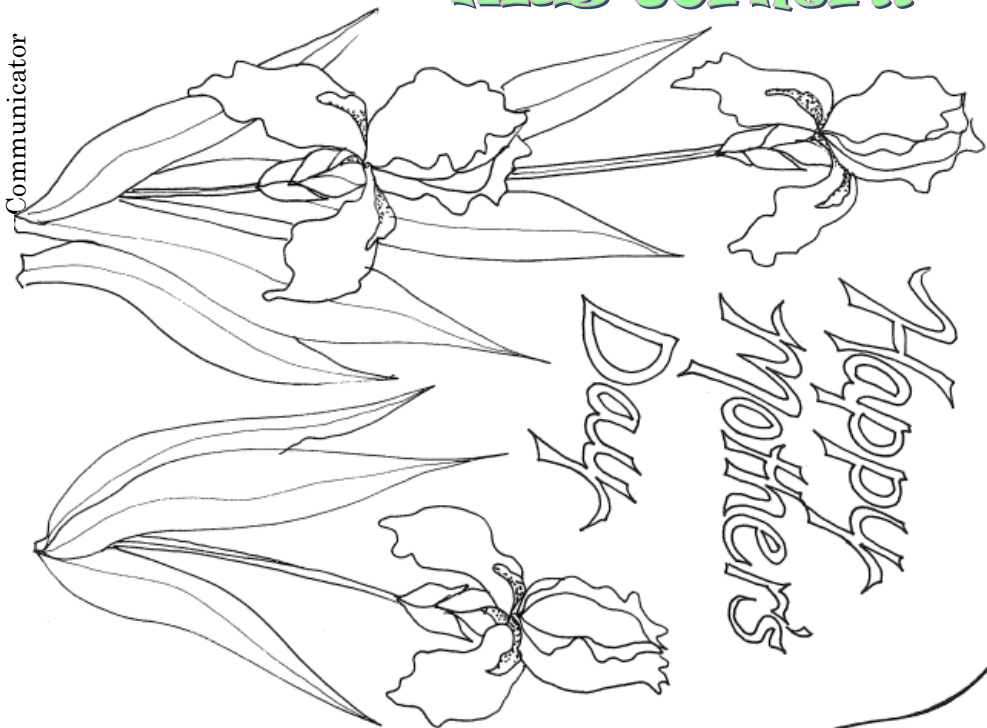

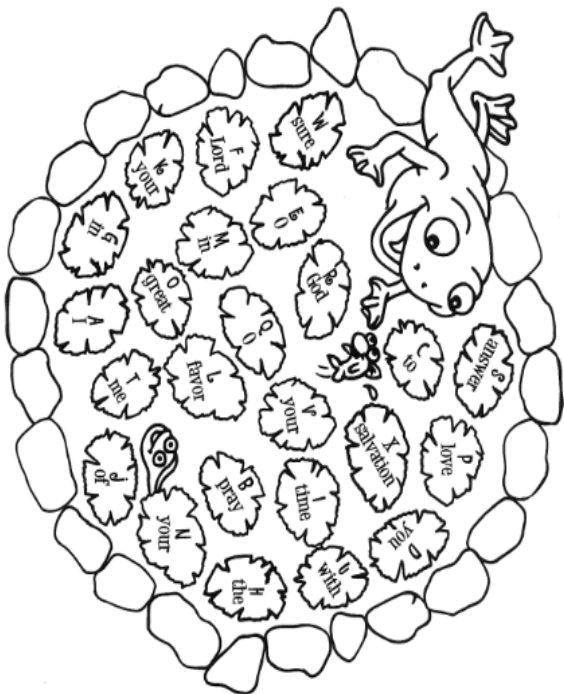
