I know we have many other NCBN church members who are DR trained or would like to be. And I believe our Network has the potential to really make an impact for God's Kingdom through the ministry of Disaster Relief. Better communication about recovery needs and about opportunities to respond is certainly an area where we can become more efficient and effective. And I would like to see a gathering of DR volunteers where our team members can be encouraged and where communication issues can be improved.

On Tuesday, April 2, a line of severe storms rolled through our area bringing with it several tornadoes. At least one of those tornadoes caused damage in the Prospect area and in Henry County. In the aftermath of the storms, I had the opportunity to participate in a Kentucky Baptist Disaster Relief effort to help cleanup and clear away debris at a couple of the homes that were impacted in Prospect. The team worked at several homes on April 13, 15, and 16.

The chainsaws and other equipment for the team were supplied out of our NCBN chainsaw trailer that Chris brought to the job sites. For now, I am thankful to the Lord for how He brings love and hope to people through the ministry of Disaster Relief and through our Network churches who help those in need and bring them the Good News of Jesus.



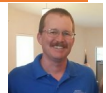

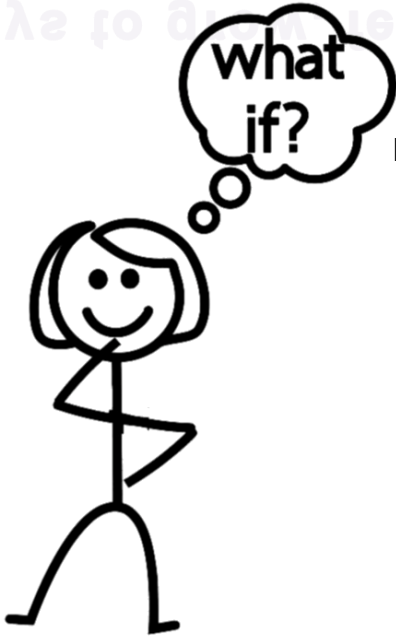

TOMMY PURVIS

Union Grove Baptist Church

Tommy Purvis has recently become pastor of Union Grove Church in Trimble County, where he has served as interim since the death of their beloved pastor, Phillip Bruce.

Born in New Albany, Mississippi, he served as Extension County Agent after studying at Mississippi State University and prior to being called into vocational ministry.

Following degrees from Southern and Asbury Seminaries, he served as pastor of Ballardsville (building & relocating) and DeHaven (church restart) in Oldham County.

He reflects, "I saw the Lord's miracles as faithful believers followed His leading."

Retiring in 2013, he has served supply & interim pastorates, participated in biker ministries, and raised awareness & funds for Shriners Hospitals For Children.

Tommy's wife, Carla, is retired from the Kentucky Baptist Convention, where she served in Minister Church Staff Relations, Partnership Missions, and Evangelism Divisions.

They are the parents of 3 daughters and 4 grandchildren. They lost one daughter, Stacey, to Cystic Fibrosis, which gave them a deep appreciation

for pastoral ministry and the value of fellow believers in times of crisis.

Their oldest daughter, Dorian, is a stay at home mom after being an elementary teacher. Lydia is a dentist at Home of the Innocents-ministering to special needs, immigrant, and refugee children. In addition, she serves in the pediatric clinic at The University of Louisville. Her son, Elijah, has Autism, which has taught them much about serving special needs individuals. Therefore, their work serving Shriners Hospitals comes quite naturally.

Union Grove Church is literally a "union church," made up of both Baptist and Christian Church members, who demonstrate the value of cooperating in the mission of the New Testament Church-loving God and one another, giving, and participating in ministry and mission endeavors. Their attitude toward one another, the community, and the world reflects the subject of his doctoral dissertation: "Partnership in Cross-cultural Mission," a study of the impact on local church members participating in Kingdom's work...

Tommy occasionally recalls: "Thought I retired in 2013, but apparently the Lord still has something for me to do. Actually, that's true for all of us in all phases of life!"

Newsletter Article May 2024

Grace and peace to you in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ from your Church Health and Leadership Team! We wanted to update you on a couple of things that will be coming soon for our Network Churches over the summer months.

First, the CHL team will be making available to each Network church a free book and devotional resource for the purpose of helping leadership and congregations manage everyday conflict. Our good friend Alan Witham has wisely stated, “people often ask for help when a conflict is at the triage stage. Churches should not wait till it reaches that point to prepare for conflict.” Our team wants to help churches accomplish that goal at no cost. We will have much more to share very soon.

Second, we have been discussing and praying through the best options for helping churches develop robust policies and procedures for preventing abuse of any kind. Southern Baptists are passionate about the safety of our people, especially our kids. Toward the end of the summer, we will have an educational opportunity through one of the most respected abuse prevention ministries in the country. Dates

and details will be released in June.

Third, this year’s Annual Meeting of the Southern Baptist Convention will be addressing a variety of important and somewhat contentious issues. I will be providing a briefing on the most pressing and relevant issues for my church members who are attending as messengers, and I would like to open that up to any Network church member who is traveling to Indianapolis as a messenger. The briefing will be on Saturday, June 1st at 9:00 am at Graefenburg Baptist Church. My hope is that this will allow messengers to attend the meeting well prepared for the motions and votes that will take place.
