Good morning. My name is Marc Webb. I am the pastor of Victory Baptist Church in Shelbyville. I am also serving as the Prayer and Communication Coordinator for Kentucky Changers 2024.

If you are unfamiliar with Kentucky Changers, this is a youth summer program that is sponsored by Kentucky WMU and works in partnership with local associations/networks. This ministry gives young people, going into grades 8 through 12, opportunities to assist with home repair and to engage in gospel conversations. Kentucky Changers will be in Henry County the week of June 22-28, 2024. If you would like more information about this event, you can contact me directly. You can also contact Bro. Jon or Amanda at the Network Office. They currently have brochures and homeowner applications available.

In making plans for this special week, we believe that prayer should be the foundation of all that we do going forward. In the words of Billy Graham, "Prayer is crucial. Our words (and actions) will accomplish nothing unless God's Spirit prepares the way."

In serving as our Network's Prayer Coordinator, I need your help and assistance. Will you partner with us by creating a prayer team within your congregation? This can be a select group of individuals, a Sunday School class, or a prayer committee that you are already utilizing within the church. It could also be the entire congregation, if you would like. We are simply asking for your church to have a group of individuals, who will commit to pray for Kentucky Changers every week, starting now and continuing through June of next year.

Each month, I will email your pastor and church, in order to update you on the steps being implemented by the leadership team and I will pass along specific requests for your prayer team/congregation to lift up.

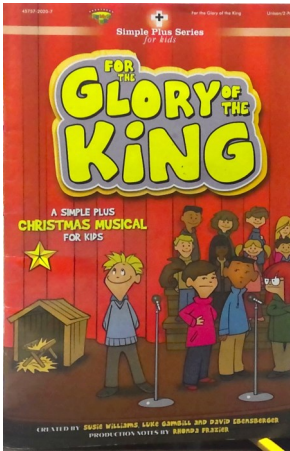

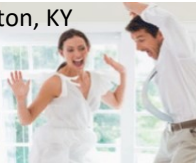

We hope the ladies in your church will join us for this special time of prayer and fellowship.

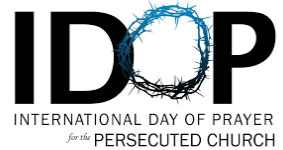
