Good morning. My name is Marc Webb. I am the pastor of Victory Baptist Church in Shelbyville. I am also serving as the Prayer and Communication Coordinator for Kentucky Changers 2024.

If you are unfamiliar with Kentucky Changers, this is a youth summer program that is sponsored by Kentucky WMU and works in partnership with local associations/networks. This ministry gives young people, going into grades 8 through 12, opportunities to assist with home repair and to engage in gospel conversations. Kentucky Changers will be in Henry County the week of June 22-28, 2024. If you would like more information about this event, you can contact me directly. You can also contact Bro. Jon or Amanda at the Network Office. They currently have brochures and homeowner applications available.

In making plans for this special week, we believe that prayer should be the foundation of all that we do going forward. In the words of Billy Graham, "Prayer is crucial. Our words (and actions) will accomplish nothing unless God's Spirit prepares the way."
