I am excited about our upcoming Fall Semi-Annual Meeting this month! I hope you are as well. Each time our churches gather in this way, we have an opportunity to fulfill our Network mission to one another. Encouraging, strengthening, and supporting our churches as they make disciples of Jesus Christ for the glory of God has been foremost in the minds of our Fall Meeting planning team.

Each of the four breakout sessions has been selected to help church leaders and members grow in their faith, gain skills and understanding for ministry, or learn more about how we work together as Southern Baptists. Here's what you can expect from these sessions:

- What is evangelism: How-Where-When. Chris Platt (Highland BC) Have you ever wondered how you can be more effective in evangelism? This session will be stuffed with practical and creative ways to share your faith in a culture that may be more receptive than you think.
- How to build a leadership pipeline at your church. Rick Davidson (LaGrange BC) When we consider church growth, do we grow the church to build leadership or build leadership to grow the church?
- Connecting our music to the Word in worship. Rodrigo Dias de Souza (LaGrange BC) In this breakout session we will look on how the word of God shapes our worship services and help us to respond to Him with a true heart in full assurance of faith, making music and every part of the service flow out of His own words.
- Southern Baptist Convention 2023 RE-Cap. Philip Meade (Graefenburg BC) This breakout session will summarize the most important issues presented at the 2023 Annual Meeting of the Southern Baptist Convention in New Orleans.

The Book of Reports will be full of ministry partner reports, Network team highlights, and other pieces that show how God is at work among our Network churches. This includes reports from the individuals who received Salazar International Mission Trip Scholarships this past spring. We also have a couple of exciting items of business to take action on during the business session. The highlight of our afternoon will come as we gather to worship the Lord together, lifting our hearts and voices in song and prayer. Bro. Paul Briscoe (Lockport BC) will be bringing the message and challenging us to hear and respond in faith to the Word of the Lord.
